WELCOME TO THE CORGI JANUARY TO APRIL 2023 RANGE!

WELCOME TO THE FIRST CORGI CATALOGUE for 2023, revealing new announcements for products due to arrive between January and April this year, as well as some previews and pre-orders for future products that will be coming later on in the months ahead.

The Corgi range in 2023 has been tailored to present a variety of returning favourites for collectors alongside a host of brand new and innovative tooling across the ranges that make up this classic British die-cast brand. Our Aviation Archive, Vanguards and - at long last - Original Omnibus ranges will all benefit from newly tooled models designed to delight collectors old and new, with the new releases benefiting from intense research and development that has already been underway during the past year.

You can also look forward to new products in our pop culture collections with some of the

highlights including another newly designed model from James Bond's most recent screen adventure 'No Time To Die', the debut of our new Wallace & Gromit product range, the most accurate scale recreation ever made of the iconic Triumph Trophy TR6 motorcycle from the classic film 'The Great Escape', new music licenced products from two of the most iconic Heavy Metal bands in the world, and the return of Star Trek to the Corgi portfolio after nearly two decades away.

2023 will be Corgi's most exciting year in a very long time, and we're eager to show and share with you what we've been working on. Read on for previews of some of the fantastic products coming soon, and stay turned to the fortnightly Corgi Die-cast Diaries blog on **www.corgi.co.uk** for development updates on everything featured here and much more besides.





The Aviation Archive range features high quality die-cast aircraft models produced in both 1:72 and 1:48 scales. Newly designed packaging styles highlight each model's place in real-world history, enabling collectors both new and old to easily identify areas of interest while expressing the sheer span and scope of the aviation world. Each aircraft comes with a display stand and many have optional parts enabling the model to be posed either in flight or stationary with the undercarriage down.

This year Corgi will return several classic aircraft models to the Aviation Archive that have been much requested by collectors, and we will have two more new tools to add to the range. We have been working for over a year already on a new 1:72 scale tool of the Martin B-26 Marauder. Our model will be the most accurate representation of the type ever produced in diecast, having been LIDAR scanned from one of the few surviving airframes in existence. Our 1:48 scale jet aircraft collection will also continue to grow with the arrival of the Panavia Tornado GR1/GR4. Again LIDAR scanned from actual aircraft, this incredible model will be a true showpiece addition to any Aviation Archive collection.






