





The Aviation Archive range features high quality die-cast aircraft models produced in both 1:72 and 1:48 scales. Newly designed packaging styles highlight each model's place in real-world history, enabling collectors both new and old to easily identify areas of interest while expressing the sheer span and scope of the aviation world. Each aircraft comes with a display stand and many have optional parts enabling the model to be posed either in flight or stationary with the undercarriage down.

As promised in our previous announcement catalogue, several long absent Aviation Archive models are rejoining the range this year. In July we announced the much-requested Canberra would be returning in a surprise reveal at the Royal International Air Tattoo, and now another much loved aircraft is back - the Fairey Swordfish. We've also created some new components to produce a long-awaited Messerschmitt Me 109-E nightfighter.

Progress continues apace on our new tool B-26 Marauder in 1:72 scale, and Panavia Tornado GR1/4 in 1:48 scale – you can expect pre-orders to open for both in the new year. Ahead of those and due in the next few months is our new tool BAE Harrier II in 1:48 scale, returning one of the most iconic aircraft ever to fly to the CORGI® range in spectacular form.






