WELCOME TO THE CORGI® SEPTEMBER TO DECEMBER 2024 RANGE!

FLCOME TO THE THIRD AND FINAL V CORGI® catalogue for 2024, detailing all the new items due to be released between September and December this year. As we head towards the festive season we bring the focus onto products suitable for gifting, with perhaps the ultimate nostalgic stocking filler arriving after forty years of absence from the CORGI® range - the 267 Batmobile with Batman and Robin. This fantastic action feature filled model is a brand-new tool recreation of the classic toy from the late 1960s. Other new items in the range include a new release featuring everyone's favourite bear Paddington, as well as some new entries in our Motörhead and Iron Maiden product ranges and the completion of our long

running collection of London Buses featuring the legendary album artwork of The Beatles.

Our core Collectors aren't left out though, with the Aviation Archive range featuring new models from our First World War range, the second release of our newly tooled 1:48 scale BAE Harrier II and the long-requested debut of the Rolls Royce Heritage Hangar's Supermarine Spitfire PR.XIX as a Special Edition release. Meanwhile in Vanguards we are delighted to release a deluxe new collectors set of vehicles produced for Henry Ford II when he visited the UK. Each of the four vehicles replicated in the set were produced to unique specifications for the then-chairman of the Ford Motor Company, making this collection the only place to own models of some true motoring royalty.





This latest range announcement follows up on the surprise reveal at this year's Royal International Air Tattoo of CORGI's very first 'What If?' Aviation Archive model in the form of a BAC TSR-2 decked out in an operational camouflage livery. This model was in the planning for the past two years, and was specifically released to commemorate the 60th anniversary of the cancelled aircraft's first flight in September 1964. It has proven hugely popular among collectors and by the time this catalogue reaches you may have already sold out!

Our new models in this selection include two new releases in our First World War collection, including perhaps the most intricately decorated model we've ever produced with our latest Albatros D.V. We also have two RAF Second

World War bombers that operated in very different environments: a desert scheme Bristol Beaufort Mkl that served in Egypt, and a Lancaster bomber outfitted with the enormous Tallboy bomb as an excellent example of what RAF 617 Squadron did after the legendary Dambusters raid - the sinking of the infamous German Battleship Tirpitz in wintery Norway.

In modern aircraft, our second release of the 1:48 scale BAE Harrier II arrives in the striking camouflage livery created to commemorate the retirement of the type in March 2011, and another UK airshow favourite joins the Aviation Archive range with the Supermarine Spitfire PR.XIX operated by the Rolls Royce Heritage Hangar.
