WELCOME TO THE FIRST CORGI® catalogue for 2025, revealing our brand-new releases due to arrive between January and April. As you'll see from our front cover, we're thrilled to be returning to the Final Frontier with our first brand new tool *Star Trek* model in almost 20 years – the movie refit version of the *U.S.S. Enterprise NCC-1701*, first commanded by Admiral James T. Kirk as played by William Shatner in *Star Trek: The Motion Picture* in 1979. This heavy weight and highly detailed model is presented in our deluxe collector edition *Star Trek* packaging.

2025 also brings the 60th anniversary of one of the most beloved children's action-adventure television series of all time, *Thunderbirds*. CORGI® is going all in with a reimagined range of models celebrating Gerry Anderson's

creation, featuring premium collector packaging and improved decoration with some brand-new tooled models to come later this year!

Our core collector ranges haven't been forgotten though. Aviation Archive features some long absent models returning to the range, not least the Corsair Mk.II which we're reintroducing for the first time in 17 years! In *Vanguards*, we have new releases of the Rover P6 and Triumph TR7 alongside some favourite Fords, including two very special Ford Escort Mk4 XR3is! Plus as you leaf through these pages you'll find some updates on new tool models coming in the months ahead!


As we enter our 69th(!) year, CORGI® is looking to represent the very best of heritage, history, and popular culture in the products we offer to our collectors and new fans. We can't wait to reveal what is coming in the year ahead, and what we have planned as we prepare to celebrate our 70th anniversary in 2026!



THE AVIATION ARCHIVE

As we enter 2025, the Aviation Archive range features some returning classics that haven't been in the range for many years. Chief amongst these is the return of the Corsair Mk.II for the first time since 2007! One of the most famous aircraft types of the Pacific Theatre, this example recreates a clipped wing FAA aircraft that was flown by the highest scoring Canadian ace in the type. Other new models include the Focke-Wulf Fw 190 flown by Otto Kittel - again the highest scoring ace in the type but also the highest scoring ace to be killed in combat - and arguably the most beautiful P-51D Mustang flying in Europe, recreating the aircraft named 'Jersey Jerk'.

We are now also full steam ahead on development work on the tool of the Messerschmitt Me410 *Hornisse* in 1:72 scale, featuring a robust suite of options to cover the incredible flexibility of this aircraft - not least the fitting of the BK 5 cannon in the nose, derived from the 50mm gun from the Panzer III tank and intended to shoot down American heavy bombers in a single shot. We revealed the first look at the development CAD in our *Die-Cast Diaries* blog late last year and stay tuned there for more updates as we continue to progress with this exciting new project this year.

Every model is secured to a removable display plinth and presented in a high quality Perspex display box, with each release including a limited edition numbered certificate which details the full fascinating history of the vehicle concerned.

We are speeding ahead with development work on our new tool Ford Fiesta Mk2 at present, with the tooling set to feature everything from the basic Poplar Plus to the top spec XR2. The inclusion of another Fiesta in the Vanguards range is long overdue, especially now this beloved vehicle family has ceased production with Ford. We've also had a great time working with Richard Hammond over the past year to introduce a new collection of models that have passed through the workshop doors of his classic car restoration business, *The Smallest Cog*. Starting with his Ford Escort Mk2 RS2000 in Midnight Blue, you can look forward to some more vehicles coming from this special collaboration later this year.




